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

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2. Be able to explain the layout of the field.

## 4. How does the game start?



The game commences in centre field. The players line up in pairs side by side and one behind the other, each team standing closest to the goal it is defending. The No. 1's are in front, then the No. 2's and the No. 3's at the back. He umpire throws the ball in overarm from the side line, high between the players.

5. Show the correct grip of the stick.
